13. CHAN-CES NOW, CHANCES NOW, I DON'T GO TO HIS SHOW A-NY-MORE,
14. THIS IS HOW [ⓔ], HE IS GET-TIN' OL-DER THAN BE-FORE,

19. IN A FRESH, MEM-O-RIES, LIKE A WON-DER-FUL WON-DER-FUL SONG,
